

DANSE ALLEMANDE

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A l'occasion des fêtes de carnaval, Mozart a coutume de composer des séries de danses diverses : ländler, menuets, allemandes... Cette danse allemande appartient à une série de trois, composées l'année de la "Flûte Enchantée".
